On July 17, 1841, a group of men and women met with the purpose of organizing a conference with the intention of becoming a Regular Baptist Church. There were ten members. Services were held with regularity, baptizing and receiving members, although the first minister was not called until April 2, 1842. By 1851, they had constructed a new church building, still standing proud and strong.

- We will use our God given knowledge to instruct one another, use our spiritual gifts to bless one another, use the Word of Christ to teach and admonish one another, and nurture one another toward spiritual maturity measured by the life and ministry of Jesus. ***Romans 15:14, 1 Corinthians 12:7, Colossians 3:13, Ephesians 4:13***
- We will confess our sins to one another, pray for each other, warn those who are idle, encourage the discouraged, help the weak, be patient with one another, forgive one another as the Lord forgave

us, and gently restore those who sin. ***James 5:16, I Thessalonians 5:14, Colossians 3:13, Galatians 6:1***

- We will not talk negatively about one another, not pass judgement on one another, not put any stumbling block in another's way, not be morally impure, not use obscenities, not be greedy, but we will be filled with the Spirit. ***James 4:11, Romans 14:13, Ephesians 5:3-4, Ephesians 5:18***
- We will let the light of our godly lives shine together to bring glory to God. ***Matthew 5:16***
